Old North State Posse 2008 Activities

Outstanding accomplishments for the ONSP membership in 2008!! This does not include all of the other regional (Mule Camp and Mason Dixon) and other state honors that this talented group took home in 2008.

- We continued to clean up the ONSP web site and make sure that information on the web site is current and the site operates as intended. The ONSP web site has been updated for the 2009 activities – ONSP and Shoot for the Loot applications for 2009 are now available via the web site. As always, thanks to Camille Enoich for her continued support on this effort. She continues to refine the ONSP web site to make updating information and getting ready for the next year easier.
- ONSP continued cleaning up the prop storage areas. We finally got all of the old scrap and prop junk in the dumpsters. The storage shed was emptied of some stuff that was either junk or simply not used. We have added some new storage units in the storage shed to help keep things organized going forward. We also recently completed refurbishing the bolts used to hang the targets and getting them better organized with some new metal storage units. The threads had gotten damaged on many of the bolts so we cleaned those up. We also now have a list of some other equipment that is no longer being used that we hope to "relocate" to a better home. - The scoring software used by ONSP was again upgraded to a new release of the software (SASS Premier Scoring System). We still need to find some additional members that are interested in learning how to use the software to perform the monthly match registration and scoring process. The ONSP Annual Membership Meeting

The ONSP annual membership meeting was held after the regular ONSP December match at the RCWA club house. - We will continue to look at opportunities to add additional shelter capacity for prop storage. Anyone have some cost effective options for our consideration?

- We will continue to look for some opportunities to add some new props to the ONSP inventory.
 - We are discussing the addition of some new fold up tables that can be used for staging props and guns in matches. It makes them easy to move around where needed and store in the equipment shed. Saddleburr Jack made some tables of this type that were used in the 2008 NC State Championship. These tables are apparently period correct from the Civil War time period.
 - O We would also like to create some new horse props on which we could mount some saddles for use in that shooting from horse back experience.
- We will continue to evaluate the steel target inventory and replace as needed and/or add additional targets.
- We will continue to look for ways to make the ONSP web site a bit more active keep new information, pictures, etc. flowing through the site. We are still looking at reactivating the cowboy/cowgirl profile section of the web site and finding a way to post photos of club activities.
